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CLINICAL PRECEPTOR ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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The preceptor responsibilities will include student orientation, liaison with SHSU students, supervision, and clinical teaching within the clinical agency. This document follows rule 215.10 of the Texas Board of Nursing, rules and regulation.

Preceptor Requirements:

- (A) Competence in designated areas of practice;
- (B) Philosophy of health care congruent with that of the nursing program; and
- (C) Current licensure or privilege to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Texas.

Faculty Responsibilities:

- x Shall provide written clinical objectives to the clinical preceptors or clinical teaching assistants prior to or concurrent with the experience.
- x Shall be responsible and accountable for managing clinical learning experiences and observations of students including supervision and scheduling of students
- x Collaborates with the preceptor L Q W K H V X S H U Y L V L R Q D Q G H Y D O X D W L R Q R I W K I
- x (G X F D W H V W K H S U H F H S W R U) Collaborates with the preceptor to provide appropriate student assignments and clinical experiences.
- x Communicate assignments and other essential information to the agencies.
- x Meet regularly with the clinical preceptor and the student in order to monitor and evaluate the learning experience.
- x Monitor student progress through rounds, student clinical seminars, student-faculty-preceptor conferences and review of student clinical assignments.
- x Be readily available, e.g., telephone, pager or email for consultation when students are in the clinical area.
- x Receive feedback from the preceptor regarding student performance.
- x Provide feedback to preceptor regarding performance as preceptor and the clinical learning experience.
- x Provide recognition to the preceptor for participation as a preceptor.

Agency Responsibilities:

- x Retain ultimate responsibility for the care of clients.
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otation. x Interpret the preceptor program and expectations of students to other agency personnel who directly involved with preceptorship.

**During clinical learning experiences, students may not be utilized for health care staffing.

- x Orient the student(s) to the clinical agency.
- x Guide, facilitate, supervise and monitor the student in achieving the clinical objectives. Supervise student's performance of skills and other nursing activities to assure safe practice.
- x Collaborate with faculty to review the progress of the student toward meeting clinical objectives.
- x Provide direct feedback to the student regarding clinical performance.
- x Contact the faculty if assistance is needed or if any problem with student performance occurs.

- x Collaborate with the student and faculty to formulate a clinical schedule.
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
