PresidenHoyt recognized outgoing chair and senators for their service

President Hoyt and Provost Eglsaer spoke about:

The vote by the Texas Higher Education Coordination Board on the School of Osteopathic Medicinewhich passed 5/4.16 described the political fight with the commissioner of the board over the plan.

They addressed senator's concerns including:

x The broken elevators in the Lee Drain building and the instance of a wheelchair bound student being stuck on an upper floor due to the brokerateles. President Hoyt said she would bring it up with the approximate groups on campus. Sheentioned there are funds set aside to overhaul the Lee Drain building.

- x Accessibility for disabled students across campus. Mention of websity of Houston study mapping accessibility of Texas universities and SHSU scoretlypThe Student government's autumnsafety walk and the Faculty Senate's participation in the exercise was highlighted as a means to identify problem of that we work hard to correct inaccessibility when they become aware of it. Topography of campus is an inherent problem.
- x The cost of parking. President Hoyt said that the costs are not going to get cheaper.
- x The status of adjuncts, the number of classes they're asked to atedtheir pay. The Presidentand Provost discussed some of the complexities of the istateCalbinet of Deans is discussing measutesimprove things. The President would welcome Senate input on this topic. Mention was made of the problem with the current analytic tools incorrectly interpreting the data. The work being done by Stephanie Fors to better the use data and metrics to apportion classes.
- x The number of grad students who are using the student foodbank is concerningning reside Hoyt acknowledged the issaed added that the problem is a concern for undergraduates. She pointed to Dean Hendrickson's work on the grad student stipend, but working to get to where we want to be this issue
