Application Definitions

Identifiable data or records contain information that reveals or can likely be associated with the identity of the person or persons to whom the data or records pertain. Research data or records with direct identifiers removed, but which retain indirect identifiers, are still considered identifiable.

Protected Health Information (PHI) means individually identifiable health information created or received by a health care provider, health plan, or health care clearinghouse that is transmitted or maintained in any form or medium.

Direct identifiers in research data or records include names; postal address information (other than town or city, state and zip code); telephone numbers; fax numbers; electronic mail addresses; social security numbers; medical record numbers; health plan beneficiary numbers; account numbers; certificate/license numbers; vehicle identifiers and serial numbers, including license plate numbers; device identifiers and serial numbers; web universal resource locators (URLs); internet protocol (IP) address numbers; biometric identifiers, including finger and voice prints; and full face photographic images and any comparable images. in(s)-1ni2(l R -0is)1(k2(e)61 .3)6cueXnb
