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Technically, yes. However, your project may be susceptible to poor scoring as proposals should be tailored to the specific grant program.

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Yes, serving on the FRC does not impact your ability to apply for internal grants. You can still apply as PI or Co-PI. If you do apply, you won't be assigned to the subcommittee reviewing the program you applied for to avoid conflict of interest.

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We are defining internal support as only the support from ORSP. So, if you have not received ORSP support, you can apply to the New Faculty Program (if you meet the other eligibility requirements such as no external support).

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Yes, the eligibility requirements only apply to PIs.

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Yes, clinical faculty are eligible to apply to the new faculty program.

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The Associate Professor title will not restrict you from applying.

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Yes, visiting assistant professors can apply.

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There is no limit for a 2nd year application thus you would be able to submit next year if you still meet all other eligibility requirements (such as having not received other internal ORSP funds or external funds by the date of submission).

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You would still be eligible if you were not the Principal Investigator for any of the grants.
