I. Policy

Ensure the rights of Sam Houston State University (SHSU) students and visitors regarding service and emotional support animals with respect to the Student Health Center (SHC) operation as a medical facility and department of SHSU.

II. Definitions

Service Animal- a dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with disability per the Americans with Disabilities Act (Attachment 1). **Emotional Support Animal**-any animal that provides emotional or other support that

- G. Any mess, including excrement, generated by the animal is the responsibility of the handler to clean up immediately. Housekeeping staff should also be notified to conduct a terminal clean of the affected area.
- H. Bites or Scratches

Any incidents of bites or scratches occurring within SHC should be reported to the clinic director in addition to following usual process for <u>Workplace</u> <u>Accidents and Injuries</u>.
